Amber Alert Criteria

Criteria	Yes/No
Is the child 17 years of age or younger?	
Is there a reasonable belief by law enforcement that an abduction has occurred?	
Does law enforcement believe the child is in imminent danger of serious bodily harm or death?	
Is there enough descriptive information about the victim and/or the abductor(s) to make the issuance of an AMBER Alert viable enough to assist in the recovery of the child?	
Has the child been entered into NCIC?	

Level II Endangered/Missing Child Criteria

Criteria	Yes/No
Is the child 17 years of age or younger?	
The child is considered to be a runaway and in danger of serious bodily harm or death.	
A noncustodial parent took the child with no threat of harm.	
The child has been abducted with no description of the abductor or vehicle.	
Has the child been entered into NCIC?	

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
